Born in Australia, Country Singer / Songwriter Bonnie Kellett is a Sydney & New York based, multifaceted performance artist working with some of the most cutting-edge and talented individuals in the entertainment industry.



Releasing in 2023, her debut album '*Hidden Spirit*', premiered in the no.2 spot on the ARIA Australian Country Music Charts. The *Govinda Doyle* produced works also making an impact landing at no.16 (ARIA Country Charts), as well as an overwhelming and an impressive no.21 on the Australian All Genres Chart.

Not one to rest on their laurels, Bonnie has continued to break ground, releasing successful follow-up singles, gaining substantial radio airplay across Australia and New Zealand, with 'Bare Feet' & 'Anything Could Happen', a collaboration with fellow country star, Billie-Jo Porter.



Deriving inspiration from artists such as *Miranda Lambert*, *Sheryl Crow* & *Shania Twain*, her music resonates & connects with audiences the world over. She is a uniquely exciting and exceptional artist who's work continues to touch the hearts and minds of audiences from across Australia and indeed the world; having been privileged to perform at such industry events including the world famous *Tamworth Country Music Festival* alongside Australia's premiere Country Music talent including *Kasey Chambers* (14x ARIA Award winning artist), *Amber Lawrence* (2023 Female Artist of the year), *Lee Kernaghan* (4xAria Award Winner), *Travis Collins* (Golden Guitar Winner) and *The Buckley's* (2xAmerican Song Writing Award Winning). Bonnie is consistently breaking new ground across multiple disciplines, showcasing her impeccable talents, some of which are looping, classic rhythmic guitar, improvisation and the electronic genre including; live fiddle. A testament to her exceptional skill, Bonnie has been nominated for many awards, honoured with a 'Mo Award', while also placing in the top ten at the highly coveted 'Kix Start' program in 2021.
